Pembrokeshire Youth Bank Grant Application Guidelines 2020/2021

Who is Pembrokeshire Youth Bank?

We are a group of young volunteers aged 14-25 from Pembrokeshire who give out grants of up to £1000 to young people with good ideas for projects that will benefit their community. Please use the checklist below before applying.

Checklist – do you have what we want?

- Are you a young person or group aged 11-25?
- Do you live in Pembrokeshire?
- Is there an adult linked to you or your group (aged over 18 years old)?
- Does your project help the community and those involved?
- Will you be able to provide evidence of the completed project (i.e. accept a visit from Youth Bank, take photos or videos, give written details of the project)?
- Are you willing to promote Pembrokeshire Youth Bank?
- Can a young person complete the application form? (Adult support is accepted.)
- Projects should meet at least one of the priorities of the Well-being of Future Generations Act 2015: <https://www.futuregenerations.wales/wp-content/uploads/2017/01/160401-wfg-accessible-guide-for-young-people-en.pdf>

If you can tick all boxes, move on to completing the Youth Bank application form!

N.B. Why not get creative and make a video to support your application: Look at the questions and film your answers. You can film the site of the project. Interview group members or people who will benefit from the project. Film the stuff you need in the shop and their prices. We still need you to fill out the application form.

If you are successful - you will receive a letter informing you of this and payment will be transferred into a business account. The grant will need to be spent by 1st March 2022, receipts provided and an evaluation report submitted.

If you are unsuccessful - You will receive a letter within 3 weeks of the deadline explaining why.
